**Minutes**

**CALL TO ORDER**

President Richard Rodriguez called the meeting to order at 12:03 p.m.

**ATTENDANCE**

Members of the Board present included Richard Rodriguez, Phil Balmat, John Herrick, Bill Koster, and Molly Watkins. Kamal Bagri (SJC Ag Commissioner's Office), Dusty Fernece (Kings Co. Farm Bureau), Krista McCoon (RCD), Sonya Miller (NRCS-Stockton), Ruth Mulrooney (SJCDWQC), and Mike Wackman (SJCDWQC), Kendra Altnow, Mike Henry, Andrea Valentin-Rios, Jeremy Hart, Laina Llano-Jorge, were also in attendance.

**MEETING AGENDA**

A motion to accept the agenda for the February 20, 2025, meeting was made by Mr. Herrick. Mr. Koster seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

**MEETING MINUTES**

A motion to accept the regular meeting minutes from January 16, 2025, was made by Mr. Herrick. Mr. Koster seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

**GUEST SPEAKER –**

Mr. Ference from Kings County Farm Bureau discussed the ongoing legal battle regarding SGMA and the Tulare Lake Subbasin. He gave an overview of the progress and status. Mr. Fernece informed the group that he is soliciting donations to offset legal fees.

**TREASURER'S REPORT**

All bills for the month were presented. A motion to pay all invoices presented in the packets was made by Mr. Koster. Mr. Herrick seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Koster moved to transfer \$13,289.45 from the RCD account to the Coalition account to correct an accounting error. Mr. Herrick seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

**NRCS UPDATE**

EQIP and Personnel Update – Ms. Miller noted that the trajectory of the office and technical assistance is changing. IRA funding, which initially increased staffing, is frozen. 2025 applications are in review. Three staff members have been let go by the administration.

**RESOURCES**

- A. Ag Commissioner's Report – Ms. Bagri noted she is looking to purchase new office space in Lodi. The Nutria Eradication Control Act will provide \$12M in funding, from which California can apply. There are more cases of High Path Avian Influenza and reinfections are being documented. Spray days reporting requirements will begin starting February 27. SJC Spray Safe will be February 28, with usually 200-300 people in attendance.
- B. CARCD (California Assoc. of Resource Conservation Districts) Report – Ms. Watkins discussed the CARCD board changed the name of the JEDI committee without consent of the board. She also noted the treasurer recently reported the line of credit they secured was for \$4M more than initially discussed.
- C. RCD Administrator Update – Ms. McCoon noted the 23/24 audit was complete and will be provided next month.

## **IRRIGATED LANDS REGULATORY PROGRAM**

- A. Financial Report – All bills for the month were presented. Ms. Watkins moved to pay coalition invoices as presented and accept and file the financial report. Mr. Koster seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
- B. Program Report – The program manager's report was included in the packet.

- D. Membership Report – Ms. Mulrooney noted there are approximately 124 members who haven't paid the management zone fee. She also asked for direction regarding the 7-9 members who are past due and or trying to join the coalition.
- E. Delta Regional Monitoring Program – Mr. Wackman noting things are progressing and a presentation will be given to the regional water board.
- F. CV Salts/Valley Water Collaborative – Mr. Wackman noted that fees will increase this coming year, but due to paying upfront for startup costs, the coalition should get approximately \$20K back.
