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Minutes

CALL TO ORDER

President Richard Rodriguez called the meeting to order at 11:09 a.m.

ATTENDANCE

Members of the Board present included Richard Rodriguez, Phil Balmat, Jack Hamm, Bill Koster, Jim Thoming, and Diego Olagaray. Brandon Bates (NRCS), Krista McCoon (RCD Administrator), Ruth Mulrooney (SJCDWQC), and John Thoming (past director) were also in attendance.

MEETING AGENDA

A motion to accept the agenda for the December 15, 2022, meeting was made by Mr. Balmat. Mr. Olagaray seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

MEETING MINUTES

A motion to accept the regular meeting minutes from November 17, 2022, was made by Mr. Balmat. Mr. Olagaray seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

TREASURERS REPORT

All bills for the month were presented. A motion to pay all invoices presented in the meeting and supplemental packets was made by Mr. Koster. Mr. Olagaray seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

- A. Ag Commissioner's Report – Via email, Ms. Pinfold updated the group that Ms. Kamal Bagri has been appointed as the SJC Agricultural Commissioner and will start December 19, 2022.
- B. CRAE Report – No report.
- C. RCD Administrator – Ms. McCoon provided the group her review of the CARCD conference from early December. She also reviewed the audit engagement letter, which was received via mail. Mr. Koster moved to authorize SJCRCD President Richard Rodriguez to sign the engagement letter with Croce, Sanguinetti, and Vander Veen to complete the 2022 audit. Mr. Hamm seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously. Ms. McCoon also discussed that the SAM update, although arduous, was complete. She also noted the RCD provided a letter of support to Stanislaus State for a grant they are applying, which could provide the RCD with an intern.

NRCS UPDATE

- A. EQIP Update –Inflation Reduction Act funds (\$20B for the country) are set to be available in January and will be staggered and increasing for the next couple of years. There will be an increase in funds available with the Regional Conservation Partnership Program for projects focusing on groundwater recharge, drought, air quality, climate change, etc.

- B. Personnel – A new ag engineer has been hired and should be here in January. The office is currently down two planners.

IRRIGATED LANDS REGULATORY PROGRAM

- C. Membership Report – Ms. Mulrooney stated that INMP packets are being prepped for January mailing. Electronic packets will be available for larger producers.
- D. Program Report – Ms. Mulrooney discussed a potential water recharge or restoration project at the property on the NW corner of Liberty Road & Hwy 99. It was owned by the Delta College District, but sold to SJCOG, Inc. The board directed staff to reach out to see if they'd be interested in partnering on this project.
